Purpose: To create a team culture where all are encouraged to grow, learn, and compete within the Ultimate community.

Objectives:

1. To build community
2. To teach the fundamentals of Ultimate Frisbee.
3. To help players develop confidence in themselves and their abilities.
4. To have fun.

Membership Requirements:

1. Each member must be a full-time ASU student.
2. Each member must have a positive attitude as well as a willingness to learn.
3. From the time of registration, players are collegiately eligible for five years.

Member Responsibilities:

1. Each member must participate in practices and travel to tournaments whenever possible.
2. Each member is to play with sportsmanship in the Spirit of the Game.
3. Each member will strive to reach a standard of physical fitness.

Officer Responsibilities

- Represent the club responsibly
- Recruit new club members at the beginning of each semester
- Maintain open communications with Club Sports
- Act as positive role members

Co-Presidents

- Run targeted, efficient, and fun practices
- Ensure club members have completed USAU eligibility requirements in sufficient time before the post-season series
- Handle decisions regarding the hiring of coaches and determining the extent of their authority
- Maintain an environment conducive to individual safety on and off the field

Secretary

- Fill out travel forms and competition reports in accordance with Club Sports policy
- Write articles for Club Sports Illustrated
- Administer the team website/AppSync

Treasurer

- Maintain accurate records of all team financial actions
- Track player payments of dues each semester
- Administer team bank accounts
- Attend monthly meetings with the assigned Club Sports Executive officer

Club Sports Representative

- Represent the club at all Club Sports meetings
- Inform other officers of all pertinent information regarding Club Sports
- Maintain an active social media presence for the team

Fundraising Chair

- Seek out and create opportunities to raise money for team expenses
- Work with treasurer to meet fundraising goals

Elections: The elections for team officers will be held in March for the following school year. All elections are on a nomination and majority voting system. Requirements for eligible nominees are as follows:

1. At least one year of experience on the ASU Men 's ultimate team .
2. Committed to participate the following year.
3. A positive team leader both on and off the field.

Faculty Advisor: The faculty advisor's role is to oversee all Club activities, either directly or indirectly. To advise team leaders in cases of emergencies or procedural problems.

Team Meeting: Meetings will take place every 1st practice of the week. All team business and other concerns will be addressed at such time. Meeting procedure is that of an open forum lead by the team leaders and officers. All team members will have the right to input their concerns.

Amendments: Amendments to the constitution can be added at any time upon request for amendments by team officers. The constitution is kept on file in the CSIL. Amendments may be passed with a majority vote.

Ratification: The constitution will be ratified by a majority vote by team members when team officers agree upon said constitution. (Let it be known that this constitution was passed unanimously on Thursday September 18, 1997 for the 1997-1998 season.) (**Update:** The Club Sports Representative and Fundraising Chair officer positions were added on September 6, 2017) (**Update:** A revised version of this constitution was passed unanimously on Thursday, September 27th, 2019)

Supremacy Clause: This constitution of Men 's Ultimate Frisbee Club agrees and recognizes that the team and all team members must abide by the policies and procedures of Appalachian State University.

Non-Discrimination Clause: No student will be excluded from membership or participation on the basis of his or her race, color, religious status or historic religious affiliation, sex, national origin, age, political affiliation, veteran status, disability, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, or unless exempt under Title IX, gender.

Frank Clause: No officers are permitted to interact with Frank Huguenard in an official capacity while representing the club.
